ABOUT THE ELAINE CRAY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship was established by the friends and family of the late Elaine Cray, a 1969 graduate of Elizabeth Forward High School. Elaine graduated from California University of Pennsylvania in 1973 with a degree in Elementary Education and taught in the Elizabeth Forward School district for 30 years, retiring in 2022 as a third-grade teacher at William Penn Elementary. Elaine was a beloved wife, mother, sister, grandmother, friend, classmate, and teacher. This scholarship remembers the dedication, service, and love Elaine gave to others throughout her life.

TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

One scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded to a graduating senior at Elizabeth Forward High School who maintains a 3.0 or above average and attended William Penn Elementary School and had been admitted to a 2- or 4-year institution.

SELECTION PROCESS AND CRITERIA

The recipient will be selected by the EFAFA Selection Committee based upon their attendance at William Penn Elementary, a 3.0 or above grade point average, and a written response to the prompt on the next page. The applicant should have a sustained record of academic excellence, along with involvement in school activities, leadership, and/or community service. Special consideration will be given to a William Penn student majoring in education.

NOTIFICATION AND RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient will be notified by early May via e-mail or text message and a confirmation letter. The letter will inform the recipient of what needs to be provided to EFAFA to receive the scholarship. Information relating to a required thank you letter will be included with the confirmation letter.
